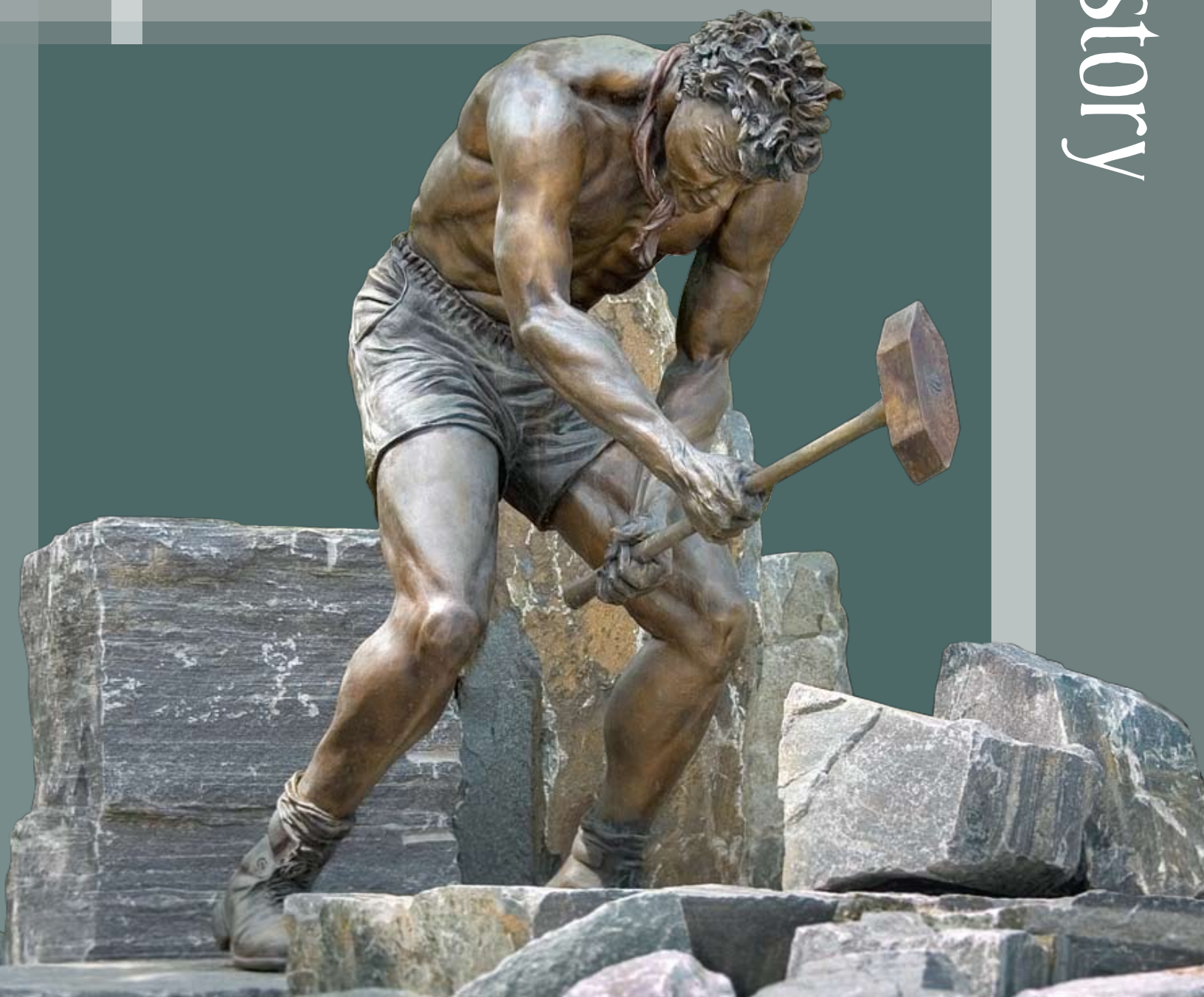



Lead Time and Delivery



Lead time for orders of Champlain Stone products vary, depending upon the product(s) ordered and the in-stock availability of the stone and cut requested. Every attempt is made to fulfill and ship orders in a reasonable amount of time. Our quarries operate on a 40-week production schedule, with little (if any) production in January and February. In the fall, we advise our dealers of our intended shut down schedule and encourage advanced planning for any large stone needs expected during the winter months.
